What is Horizons?

- A Program designed to help all citizens become involved in the development of a “Long Range Strategic Plan” for the City of Box Elder. A vision of what we want Box Elder to Become.
- A program that provides an opportunity for Citizens to meet, discuss and provide input on issues of concern to the community. A citizen Dialogue-to-Change and Problem Solving Program.
- A program whose format is designed to be all-inclusive, and to unite all citizens in a positive, approach to solving community programs.
- A program developed by the NWAFF (Northwest Area Foundation) and implemented through SDSU Extension Service to move a community from poverty to prosperity by focusing on a community’s assets and not a community’s problems.
- A program with a \$10,000 Grant Program designed to reduce poverty, improve the Quality of Life and turn Box Elder into a “Thriving Community”.
- A program that provides an excellent leadership training program for both current and developing leaders.

Who manages Horizons?

- A steering committee made up of a cross section of Box Elder Area Citizens.
- Steering committee members include those from the original group that launched the Horizon’s program plus any Study Circle, Action Committees, Leadership Plenty Participants, School, Base, BEED, BEACC, Lions Club, American Legion, Area Churches, and other group and committee representatives. (A diverse cross-section of area citizens) The Steering Committee will establish the Horizons Vision and Mission Statements, Goals, Objectives, Programs, Projects, and Manage the \$10000.00 Grant.
