Public Information Meetings for Upcoming Box Elder Roadway Projects

You are invited to attend a public information meeting hosted by the City of Box Elder Public Works Department and Towey Design Group, Inc. (TDG) regarding the street reconstruction and improvements projects for Tanglewood Lane, Gumbo Drive and Prairie Road. Separate information meetings will be held for each project.

- **Tanglewood Lane Pavement Panel Replacement**– An estimated 1,240 feet of concrete panel surface replacement. This may become a multi-phase project between Bluebird Drive and Tuscany Place. Construction work is planned for summer 2023.
 - Meeting Date: February 9, 2023, 5:30 PM to 6:30 PM
- **Gumbo Drive Pavement Reconstruction** – An estimated 850 feet of street surface replacement and drainage improvements between Box Elder Road West and Meadow Drive. Construction work is planned for summer 2023.
 - Meeting Date: February 16, 2023, 5:30 PM to 6:30 PM
- **Prairie Road Reconstruction** – An estimated 2,650 feet of extensive street reconstruction. Planned improvements include roadway widening, curb / gutter installation, and a sidewalk along west side of road. Drainage improvements will incorporate the addition of a storm sewer in Prairie Road and a new major drainage pipe crossing at Veterans Park. This is a multi- phase project with construction work scheduled for completion in both 2023 and 2024.
 - Meeting Date: February 23, 2023, 5:30 PM to 6:30 PM
