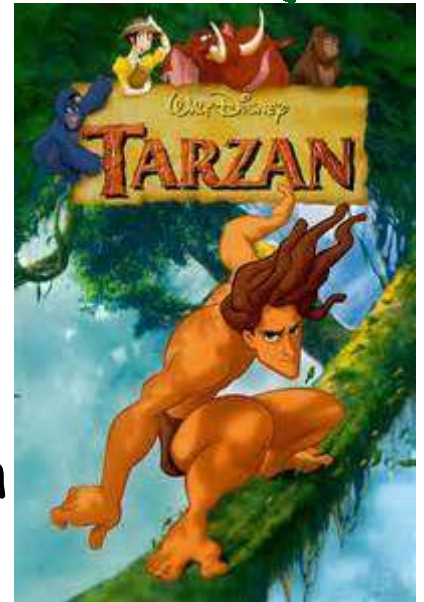

***Please note changes in our late fee and reconnect fee.**

- Payments are due by the 15th of each month
 - After the 15th, a **\$10.00** late fee will be charged
- After the 27th, services are delinquent and subject to disconnection. If water is turned off, a **\$100.00** reconnect fee will be applied. The past due balance and reconnect fee must be paid in order to get turned back on. Payment must be made by 3:30 pm in order to guarantee water turned on by 5:00 pm that day.
