

ORDINANCE # 177

An Ordinance to revise and amend Ordinance 1, and Ordinance 51, as amended being Ordinances establishing procedures for the Common Council of the City of Box Elder, South Dakota.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOX ELDER, in the State of South Dakota, as follows:

Section 1: Revises and amends Ordinance 1 as follows:

1.01: The regular meetings of the Common Council shall be held on the second and fourth Tuesday of each month, at the City Hall Building, at the hour as the Common Council shall fix from time to time. If a regular meeting date shall fall upon a holiday, the regular meeting shall be held on the following day. Special meetings of the Common Council may be called by the president of the Common Council or by any two Council Members at any time, to be upon only such matters as shall be mentioned in the call for such meetings. Remaining time may be utilized for work sessions but no action may be initiated at this time. Either written notice or telephone notice thereof shall be given to each member of the Common Council in the City. Upon demand of such call, the City Clerk shall give the notice as above specified.

1.03: (add to the end of paragraph):  
Telephone poll votes shall no longer be sufficient to take emergency action, unless all seated Common Council members have been contacted or it has been established that they are not locatable within the City of Box Elder.

Section 2: Add 1.06 to Ordinance number 1.


1.06 Compensation: The salary which is established for the Common Council, by the Common Council of the City of Box Elder, shall not be paid, to any member whom fails to be present at roll call and/or not present at time of adjournment, without a majority vote of the Council excusing them.


Section 3: Revises and amends Ordinance 51, Section 2;

Repeal in its entirety.

Section 4: All other provisions or Ordinances 1 and 51 shall remain in effect and shall not be changed by reason of this Ordinance.
