

ORDINANCE 393

An Ordinance to repeal Ordinance 20, 165, 283 and 384 to establish a one time business license fee for doing business in Box Elder;

Be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Box Elder as follows:

Section 1: Ordinance 20, 165, and 283 are hereby repealed. All business licenses for 2001, 2002 or 2003 that have been paid for at the time of the passage of this ordinance shall be deemed permanent and no further license or fee shall be required unless the business is sold or transferred and a new tax identification number is required.

Section 2: There is hereby established a business license for any person or business entity with an address in Box Elder.

Section 3: Before conducting business in Box Elder, any person or business entity shall purchase a license to do business, at a one time fee of \$25.00, from the City Finance Officer. The applicant shall fill out an application setting forth the name of the business, the address of the business, type of business, phone number, and person to be contacted for ordinance compliance or emergency purposes.

Section 4: Any new mobile home park or apartment complex shall pay a one time business license fee of five dollars (\$5.00) per lot or apartment unit. All apartment complexes and mobile home courts or parks existing at the time of the passage of this ordinance shall be grandfathered in and no further fee is required.

Section 5: Any person or business entity in violation of this ordinance shall pay a fine of \$40.00 which includes the cost of a license.

Section 6: Any new mobile home park in violation of this ordinance shall pay a fine of eight dollars (\$8.00) per lot or apartment unit.

Be it ordained that this Ordinance shall become effective in accordance to law.


