

ORDINANCE 395

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 116 PARAGRAPH 3.08A PROHIBITING THE INTENTIONAL AVOIDANCE OF TRAFFIC SIGNALS

Whereas the Common Council of the City of Box Elder, Pennington County, South Dakota believes that it is necessary for an ordinance making it unlawful for operators of motor vehicles to intentionally avoid traffic signals or devices by utilizing private property.

Be It Ordained by the Common Council of the City of Box Elder, Pennington County, South Dakota that the following described actions by motorists is deemed unlawful and that the violation of said Ordinance shall be classified as a Class 2 Misdemeanor, Fine: \$68:

Ordinance #116, Paragraph 3.08a, Prohibiting the Intentional Avoidance of Traffic Signals

It is unlawful for an operator of any vehicle to intentionally avoid any traffic signal or device by driving off the highway or street and driving across private property in order to avoid the traffic signal.


Be It Ordained that this Ordinance shall become effective in accordance to law.
